WHEN AND HOW TO ENROLL

UniMC offers a wide range of degree programmes in the fields of **Social Sciences and Humanities**. In Italy, to be eligible for bachelor's level studies, you must hold a secondary school qualification issued after a minimum of 12 years of schooling; for master's level studies, you must hold a secondary school qualification and a bachelor's degree issued after a minimum 15 years of schooling (at least 3 of which are at academic level).

ADMISSION PROCEDURE ON LINE PRE-ADMISSION APPLICATION

If you hold an International Diploma and are applying for a bachelor's or master's degree programme at UNIMC, you can follow an online pre-evaluation procedure.

PRE-ENROLMENT THROUGH THE ITALIAN CONSULATE / EMBASSY

Starting from springtime and by the deadline set by Italian Ministry of University and Research, **non -EU citizens** living outside Italy must submit the pre-enrolment application to the relevant Italian Consulate/Embassy through the portal **University.it** to apply for the visa for study reasons.

ENROLMENT FROM JULY 15TH TO OCTOBER 31ST

To complete your enrolment at UniMC, register online

and hand the Student Administration Office of your Department:

- A copy, front and back, of your valid ID;
- For non-EU citizens, a copy of a valid residence permit or an application receipt of such permit;
- A copy of your Tax Code Number;
- Any other necessary documents.

TUITION FEES

The maximum fees for a full-time enrolment in the bachelor's and master's programmes is approximately € 1600,00. **Tuition fees are to be paid in 4 instalments:**

- **1st instalment deadline** (€ 156,00 including the € 140,00 regional tax for the right to study and the € 16,00 tax stamp) is October 31st

- **2nd instalment deadline** is January 31st

- **3rd instalment deadline** is March 31st

- **4th instalment deadline** is May 31st.

The amount can be considerably reduced based on specific conditions.

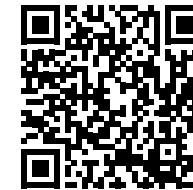

Financial Aids

Article 34 of the Italian Constitution states that “capable and deserving pupils, including those lacking financial resources, have the right to access to higher education”.

FEES REDUCTION

Regardless of the nationality, all international students may apply for a reduction on the yearly enrolment fees when enrolment and merit requirements are satisfied. The 2022/2023 a.y. enrolment fees vary as specified below:

1. Students from an extremely poor and developing country: € 156.00 per year
2. Students from a non-OECD member country: € 156.00 per year
3. Students from an OECD member country: € 387.00 per year



UNIMC SCHOLARSHIPS

In the 2022/2023 a.y., the University of Macerata offers scholarships to capable and deserving students; particularly:

- 13 scholarships only for international students who wish to enrol full-time in the first year of a master’s degree (2-year postgraduate) programme - each scholarship amounts to € 7,000.00
- scholarships for students enrolling in the first year of a bachelor’s degree (3-year undergraduate) programme
- scholarships for students enrolling in the first year of a master’s degree programme.

INVEST YOUR TALENT IN ITALY SCHOLARSHIPS

The University of Macerata is partner of the Invest your Talent in Italy (IYT) programme which offers the opportunity to students from Azerbaijan, Brazil, Colombia, Egypt, Ethiopia, Ghana, India, Indonesia, Iran, Kazakhstan, Mexico, People’s Republic of China, Tunisia, Turkey and Vietnam to attend selected master’s courses in English. The programme combines university lectures with practical

on-the-job training with an Italian company.

ERDIS SCHOLARSHIPS

The Regional Authority for the Right to Higher Education – ERDIS Marche – offers scholarships allowing economically disadvantaged and deserving students to study at UNIMC. Details of the selection process are published yearly on the ERDIS website.

Eligible students attend part of their studies at the partner University. At the end of the course, the programme allows to obtain an Italian degree and one or more foreign degree(s). Admission to double or multiple degree programme is granted on a competitive basis and is achieved through the procedures described in specific calls for application.
